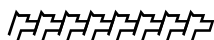

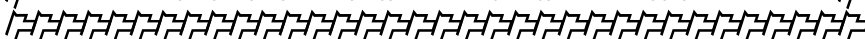

Building will be available for exhibitors **after 1:00 P.M. on Wednesday (NO EARLIER!)** until 11:00 P.M., however, exhibitors may **NOT** utilize the **South end of building until after vendor setup**. This will allow our vendors adequate time to unload and to comply with the Fire Marshal's regulations. **Building will open at 6:00 A.M. on Thursday, Friday, Saturday & Sunday. Building will close Thursday, Friday & Saturday at 10:00 P.M. On Sunday, the building will close as soon as possible after Best in Show.**

Note: All parking fees for cars are collected by a private company contracted by the Ohio State Fair Board and the Cluster Clubs do not benefit from any fees collected. **For questions or concerns regarding parking issues or fees please contact: Standard Parking (614) 294-9336.**

Parking - A five day pass is available for **\$20.00 (in/out privileges)**, four day pass is available for **\$14.00 (in/out privileges)**; or **\$5.00 per day (without in/out privileges)**. Fees subject to change.

Campers - Parking in designated spaces. Limited Electric available on fairgrounds. No dumping is allowed. Overflow camper parking across 17th Avenue where water, electric and dumping facilities are available. **Camping fee \$60.00 per day.** Subject to change. First come, first served.

Exhibitors enter at 17th Ave. Unloading at building permitted with flashers on, but then vehicles **MUST** be moved to a regular parking location. Please use the Fairgrounds parking garage or the Sheep barn, both of which are convenient to the building.

No unloading of dogs is allowed at the Southwest corner of the Multi Purpose Building.

NO PARKING in the unloading areas. **PLEASE OBEY ALL PARKING RULES. THEY WILL BE ENFORCED BY THE OHIO STATE HIGHWAY PATROL.**

A night watchman will be on duty from 11:00 P.M. - 6:00 A.M. on Wed., & from 10:00 P.M. - 6:00 A.M. Thurs., Fri. & Sat. evenings. Dogs may be left in their crates overnight.

If you do not make a reservation online for an RV spot all spots are first come first serve, with electric limited and will most likely be full with reserved spots.

RV reservations at \$60.00/night with four night minimum for reservation.

RV reservations are for 50 amp or 30 amp spaces with limited availability. You can request 50 or 30 but 50 is not guaranteed.

Reservations received in the order of purchase will be assigned the electric spaces first. Electricity is not guaranteed and dry camping is the same fee.

Electric spots may not be the closest spots to the show building! We are doing our best to have as much electricity as possible and will accommodate more RVs in additional lots on the fairgrounds.

All reservations are for the four night minimum to select electric reservation spaces.

All RV spots will be assigned by Site Control. If you park without being told the space to park in, you will have to move when notified. PLANNING YOUR APPOINTMENT TIME: *A dog's pupils start constricting again within 2-3 hours after drops so dogs with later ring times could be examined first thing in the morning. Pupil dilation does not affect the vision in dogs like it does humans because they do not accommodate (use the muscle in the iris to fine focus their vision). It can make some dogs a little light sensitive until the pupil can constrict some which is more of concern at outdoor shows on sunny days.*




- A cover page must be included with entrant's name, birth date of entrant, AKC Junior Handler number (If available), address, city, state, zip code, telephone number with area code, and E-mail address (if available).

- **Essay must be received by 5:00 P.M. EST, December 31, 2024**, by first class mail (Youth Award Committee, Central Ohio Kennel Club, Inc, 2288 Quartz St., Grove City, OH 43123); or electronically by E-mail in .pdf format only (cokcyouthaward@gmail.com). Electronic submission must include cover page.

The Central Ohio Youth Award Committee will select a winner, and their decision will be final.

Winner will be notified by January 31, 2025.

AKC Sanctioned 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy Competition

Entry Fee: \$20.00 per puppy

This is a recorded event by the AKC for the Certificate of Merit and Puppy of Achievement certificates.

Section 1 - Classifications

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over, but under six months on the first day of the event. Classes will be offered for breed and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous class competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The FSS competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show.

AKC National Owner-Handled Series

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form.

Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS.

Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner.

Chapter 16 Section 1 Rules Applying to Dog Shows

... at a Specialty the dog designated Reserve Winners Dog and the bitch designated Reserve Winners Bitch will be awarded a three-point major, provided that the number of dogs competing in the regular classes of the Reserve Winners' sex **totals at least TWICE the number required for a five point major**, in the region in which the event is held. No major for Reserve Winners shall be given based upon an award of Best of Winners.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Dogs May Arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. **Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.**

Judges Will Not Wait for Any Dog Holding Up a Class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

All Dogs Present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

Class Cash Prizes will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Superintendent's Office advised at once. The Superintendent and Show-Giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

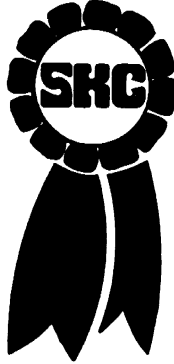

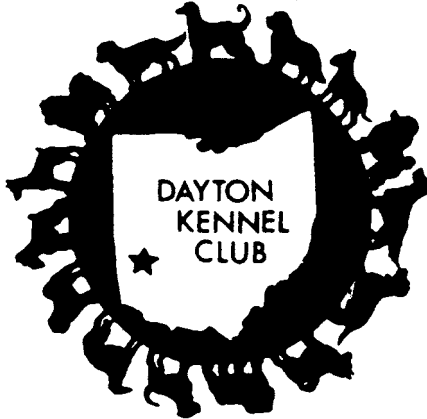

The following breeds must be judged on a Ramp through all levels of conformation competition: Lagotti Romagnoli, Clumber Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Cirneci dell'Etna, Kerry Blue Terriers, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei, Chow Chows, Keeshonden. Breeds designated as ramp optional may, at the discretion of the judge, be judged on a ramp through all levels of competition. 2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)

5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
